Horses are able to sleep while standing up! Horses can "power nap" while standing up to stay alert. For longer rests, they can lie down and reach REM cycles.












Lions live in small groups called prides!






Born tree: some monkeys can swing through branches as fast as a racehorse!





Unlike other reptiles, the male Nile crocodile will stay with a female to guard their nest of eggs!






Most sea turtles abandon their eggs on the shore, allowing them to hatch on their own before making their way to the ocean!






The female Urutu snake grows longer and heavier than males of the same species!




Viperfish have a bioluminescent spine on their dorsal fin!










They may have acted as 'gardeners' to clear vegetation and disperse seeds through their feces!






Yaks can live at altitudes up to 20,000 feet. The highest of any land-dwelling mammal!
